Elementary

To make it easier for our families with multiple ages, our teachers collaborate and plan lessons along the same themes each school year. We typically plan our offerings based on a three-year rotating schedule. Math, reading, spelling/grammar, and Bible are classes parents typically teach primarily at home.

- Rotation 1: Medieval History, The Human Body, one unit in Geology and one unit in Physics, Six-Trait Writing, music, art, PE, and Spanish.
- Rotation 2: American History, Air/Sea Creatures, Astronomy, and Weather, Six-Trait Writing, Music, Art, PE, and Spanish.
- Rotation 3: Ancient History/World Geography, Land Animals, Botany and Simple Machines, Six-Trait Writing, Music, Art, PE, and Spanish.
