Discover Our NWCS Homeschool Program

Academic and Enrichment Support for Homeschool Families within a Biblical Worldview

ELEMENTARY K-6

Our hands-on enrichment day is offered on Thursdays from 9am-3:10pm at Crossover Church. Our energetic, certified teachers provide an active and academic environment and seek to integrate a Biblical worldview into the class day. On Thursdays, students attend classes in history, science, writing, art, music, PE, and Spanish. Homeschool parents are the primary teacher(s) at home providing grades and stewarding academic progress for all core subjects.

SECONDARY (7th GRADE-12th GRADE)

Our academic class day is offered on Thursdays from 8am-3:10pm providing strong accountability. Students rotate through their classes each hour following the pattern of a traditional high school day. Our certified teachers instruct in person on Thursdays and then send home lesson plans and assignments for the remainder of the week. Students may access teachers throughout the week during teacher at home office hours and through our online assignment system. Students complete their work and turn it in the following Thursday. Grades are reported quarterly and recorded into a NWCS transcript assisting high school students and their families with their post high school preparation. Our teachers drive instruction integrating a Biblical worldview into academic subjects, and most of our curriculum is written and published by well-known Christian companies. We seek to prepare students to pursue God's plan and vision for their lives.

- Homeschool secondary students are also welcome to take a NWCS class at the high school campus for an additional fee based upon availability.
- Our secondary homeschool parents continue to play an essential role supervising, motivating and challenging their students throughout the week.
- Students in our program have the option to graduate from the NWCS Homeschool Extension Program or from the NWCS Traditional High School by completing their senior year at NWCS full-time.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR OPPORTUNITIES

Sports and extracurricular activities are an important part of a student's life. Students who are enrolled in the NWCS Homeschool Program can participate in most NWCS activities including sports, annual enrichment programming, FBLA-Business Club, chess club, extracurricular music, theater productions, academic trips, foreign language trips and chapel.
