Payment options are:

- Payment in Full
 - By May 1st
 - By check to NWCS Business Office, you will receive a 2% discount on tuition.
 - By credit Card, the card must be swiped at the Business Office. NO 2% discount
 - By August 1st
 - By check to NWCS Business Office.
 - Credit Card payments after May 1st will be processed thru FACTS. FACTS will add a 2.85% service fee to process the credit card.
- Semi-Annually, 2 payments August 2018 and January 2019, processed thru FACTS. FACTS charges a \$10 annual fee for this plan.
- Payments may be paid monthly, beginning in August for 10 or 12 months. All monthly plans are managed by FACTS thru either direct debit from your bank account or an auto charge to your credit card with an additional 2.85% credit card processing fee. FACTS charges a \$45 annual fee to use their service.

Other Fees and Expenses:

Over the course of a school year, there are times when it may be necessary for NWC to charge additional fees to cover the costs of events, programs, courses, activities, etc. This occurs most often when costs may vary from grade to grade, or level to level, or the fee covers the cost of a chosen course or activity.

Below are the estimated costs of some of the potential fees that may be incurred during the school year:

Bus Passes:

Annual Bus pass per student \$800.00 with a \$2,100 Maximum for multi student families. For those paying thru FACTS, annual passes may be rolled into your monthly tuition plan.

Monthly Bus pass per student \$125.00

Punch pass for 20 one way trips \$60.00

One-way pass \$3.00

All bus passes are non-refundable, non-transferable and only good for the current school year. Monthly, punch and one-way are subject to change throughout the year due to gas prices.

NWC does whatever possible to keep costs down making it possible for families and students to participate in and enjoy their Northwest Christian Schools experience.

Fundraising:

Northwest Christian Schools, Inc. is financed mainly by tuition and fees charged to families during the school year. However, this income does not fully cover the cost of an education at NWCS. Therefore, the school sponsors a contribution and fundraising program to make up the difference between income and expenses. You will receive information regarding these programs as the school year begins; here is a breakdown of our most prominent fundraisers.

Impact Fall Dessert Fundraiser – Contributes towards the 20% of expenses not covered by tuition.

Auction – Every family is asked to help procure items.

K-5th grade – Candy bar sales - You may choose to pay an opt out fee and not to sell.

Middle School -FunDrun: a fun, easy fundraiser that allows students to email friends and relatives to sponsor them on their own personalized website. Students may walk or run around the track to earn their sponsorships. The goal per student is \$120. You may choose to pay an opt out fee of \$120.00 (\$60 in Fall, \$60 in Spring) and not to participate

High School –

Withdrawal:

In the event a student is to be withdrawn, tuition is pro-rated on a monthly basis and will continue until the proper withdrawal process has been completed. This includes reviewing and completing the entire withdrawal process forms. The Business Office must be notified 5 days prior to your student(s)' withdrawal; otherwise your account could be charged. **Report card(s), transcript(s), and diploma(s) are released AFTER financial obligations are paid in full.**
