



## **Secondary History/Student Leadership Teacher Position Details**

- The qualified candidate will manage, organize and prepare curriculum content and related activities to teach in the classroom weekly.
- The position includes course development and implementation requiring innovation and creativity when motivating students and families to complete work through a one day a week on site and four days a week at home program.
- The successful candidate will employ a variety of methods for student learning, maintain records of weekly lesson plans and assignment progress reports and communicate weekly with families, students and staff as needed.
- This position requires maintaining an online grading system, keeping essential records and managing weekly work assignments.
- Secondary teachers must have strong speaking and listening skills and must be able to observe students and maintain discipline within the class. In addition to students, our secondary teachers interact with parents, other teachers and school administrators.
- Each 1 hour class includes 1 hour of class time, 1 hour of preparation time and 1 hour of grading pay.
- Occasional assistance with extracurricular activities to support the total program of the school is expected.
