



Preschool Teacher Position Details

Required Qualifications:

- Meet the Washington State Department of Children, Youth and Families (DCYF) requirements
- Two years of experience working with children ages infant to 5 years old
- Strong Program Building Organizational Skills
- Team Mindset Preferred

Education and Experience:

- AA in Early Learning or College Degree with at least 45 credits in Early Education
- Leadership or management role in a childcare (Preschool or Early Learning) setting

Other required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Knowledge of child development
- Ongoing relationship with Jesus Christ
- Regular Church attendance
- Ability and willingness to sign the NWCS statement of faith
- The qualified candidate will organize curriculum content and activities to teach in the classroom.
- The position includes course development and implementation requiring innovation and creativity.
- The successful candidate will employ a variety of methods for student learning, maintain records of weekly lesson plans and assignment progress reports and communicate weekly with families, students and staff as needed.
- This position requires maintaining records and providing evidence of growth and progress to parents and to students, but our teachers are not responsible for formal grading.
