### New Student Application Fee: \$75.00

This non-refundable application fee is required for each new student application. NWCS offers continuous enrollment for K-12th grade students, so as long as your student remains enrolled, you will not need to pay another application fee.

#### **Enrollment Fees:**

A non-refundable, non-transferable enrollment fee is due at the time of enrollment. This fee does not count toward tuition.

#### **Additional Fees:**

**All tuition plan payments are managed through FACTS Tuition Management** through either direct debit from your bank account or an auto charge to your credit/debit card with an additional 2.95% processing fee. Please see FACTS annual fees associated with each plan.

#### Payment options are:

- Payment in full by May 1st you will receive a 2% discount on tuition. (FACTS annual fee \$25)
- Payment in full by August 1st (FACTS annual fee \$25)
- Semi-annually, two payments August and January. (FACTS annual fee \$25)
- Payments may be paid monthly beginning in August for 10 or 12 months. (FACTS annual fee \$55)

NWCS applies a \$50 late payment fee for all returned payments, in addition to any FACTS and/or bank fees.

### Other Fees and Expenses

### **Student Withdrawal Policy**

#### Formal Withdrawal Process:

To officially withdraw a student, **both parents or legal guardians** must complete, sign, and submit an *Intent to Withdraw Form* to the Business Office at **businessoffice@nwcs.org**. A student will not be considered withdrawn until this process is fully completed.

#### Withdrawal Prior to the Start of the School Year:

**Before August 1:** No tuition will be charged for withdrawals submitted and approved before this date. **August 1 to the First Day of School:** A withdrawal during this period will incur a fee equal to 25% of the annual tuition.

#### Withdrawal During the School Year:

Parents/guardians must provide **30 days' written notice** (see process above) prior to the end of a quarter when withdrawing their child. Failure to provide the required notice will result in being charged tuition for the next quarter, equivalent to **25% of the annual tuition**.
