2026-2027 Tuition & Fees

New Student Application Fee: \$75

This non-refundable application fee is required for each new student application. NWCS offers continuous enrollment for K-12th grade students, so as long as your student remains enrolled, you will not need to pay another application fee.

Annual Enrollment Fees:

A non-refundable, non-transferable enrollment fee is due at the time of enrollment. This fee does not count toward tuition. Re-enrollment fees are charged each spring to maintain a spot for the next year.

Homeschool Multi-Student Discounts

Percentage discounts for the second student and beyond are as follows:

K-12th: 2nd student and beyond 25%
PreK Student 5%

Dual Enrolled Grade 10-12 High School Classes at Traditional High School (3 class maximum, restrictions apply, subject to availability)	\$1,850 per class
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Payment options are:

- Payment in full by May 1st you will receive a 2%
- Payment in full by August 1st. (FACTS annual fee \$25)
- Semi-annually, two payments August and January. (FACTS annual fee \$25)
- Payments may be paid monthly beginning in August for 10 or 12 months. (FACTS annual fee \$55)
- NWCS applies a \$50 late payment fee for all returned payments, in addition to any FACTS and/or bank fees.

All tuition plan payments are managed through FACTS Tuition Management and charged by either direct debit from your bank account or an auto charge to your credit/debit card with an additional 2.95% processing fee. Please see FACTS annual fees associated with each plan. Plan costs are per family.

Other Fees and Expenses

Over the course of a school year, there are times when it may be necessary for NWC to charge additional fees to cover the costs of events, programs, courses, activities, etc. This occurs most often when costs may vary from grade to grade, or level to level, or the fee covers the cost of a chosen course or activity. Below are the estimated costs of some of the potential fees that may be incurred during the school year:

Athletics

Grades K-6.....	Varies on the league + \$30 NWCS Administrative Fee
Grades 7-8.....	\$230 per sport *additional charge for football
Grades 9-12.....	\$250 per sport *additional charge for golf and football

Elementary (K-6th Grade)

Junior High & High School (7th-12th)

NWCS does whatever possible to keep costs down making it possible for families and students to participate in and enjoy their Northwest Christian Schools experience.

Withdrawal Policy K-12th Grade:

We understand that families' plans can change. If you need to withdraw your student, please notify the Business Office in writing as soon as possible. Withdrawals are considered effective only after completing the Formal Withdrawal Process.

Formal Withdrawal Process:

To officially withdraw a student, **both parents** or legal guardians must complete, sign, and submit an **Intent to Withdraw Form** to **BusinessOffice@nwcs.org**. A student is not considered withdrawn until this process is fully completed. Intent to Withdraw Forms are available in ParentsWeb/Family Portal under Resource Documents, at any campus front desk, or by requesting one from the Business Office at **BusinessOffice@nwcs.org**.

If you complete and submit your Intent to Withdraw Form for the School Year:

- **By June 30:** No tuition will be charged for withdrawals submitted and approved by this date. All enrollment fees already paid are non-refundable.
- **From July 1 through the day before school starts:** Withdrawals submitted and approved during this period will incur a fee equal to 25% of the annual tuition to help mitigate the expenses incurred for covering staffing and classroom costs reserved for your student.
- **During the School Year:** Parents/guardians must provide 30 days' written notice before the end of the current quarter when withdrawing their child for the subsequent quarter. Failure to provide the required notice will result in tuition charges for the next quarter, equal to 25% of the annual tuition.

Withdrawal Policy Homeschool PreK:

Withdrawal During the School Year: To officially withdraw a student, **both parents** or legal guardians must complete, sign, and submit an **Early Learning Intent to Withdraw Form** to **BusinessOffice@nwcs.org** fourteen (14) calendar days before student's last day. A student is not considered withdrawn until this process is fully completed. Failure to do so will result in being charged for a final half-month's tuition.
